RYTMO was designed to provide a positive, professional and creative environment for youth or troubled youth who demonstrate musical, vocal, and/or technical potential in the arts. Classes are hands-on and involve the study of Music History, Music Theory, Commercial Songwriting, Digital Recording, Music Technology, Vocal Exploration, Instrument Lessons, Performance Techniques, Live Audio/Engineering, the Business of Music and Project Development. By providing a fun and highly relevant approach to commercial music technology and recording, participants will develop practical skills in which to express their creative talents, attain greater personal and scholastic achievement, and gain fundamental occupational skills for the music industry. At the same time, RYTMO is committed to teaching life-enriching skills such as goal setting, project planning, entrepreneurship, leadership skills and work experience that will help prepare our participants for a future career in the music industry. Its instructors and mentors are made up of highly regarded leaders and music industry professionals within the community who have experience working with youth in an educational setting and have powerful professional stories that connect with our youth of today.

Instructions: Before filling out the appended Volunteer Application, please make certain that you are confident in all requirements and responsibilities expected of you upon acceptance as a Program Volunteer. This application should be completed for one individual only. This application is designed purely as a selection tool for those candidates who might feel their commitment to RYTMO will aid in the growth and achievement of each student involved in its music program and activities.

Selection Process: Selected Volunteers for RYTMO will be subject to a background check and training seminar prior to release into the program.

Responsibilities:

- · Supervise students in project development, group assignments, and individual tasks
- Support and encourage students in musical, technical, educational and other developmental skills
- Assist in operating class sessions, special workshops, and facility maintenance
- Support program staff in administrative duties and attend Volunteer meetings

Expectations:

- Volunteers should commit to a minimum of one full 9-week course.
- Must be on time and maintain consistency throughout the 9-week commitment.
- Must be confident in working with at-risk and adjudicated youth.
- Must demonstrate courtesy, civility, and encouragement to all participants regardless of ethnicity, origin, religion, gender, disability, or alternative circumstance.
- Must demonstrate patience and understanding toward youth in difficult and unprecedented circumstances.
- Must refrain from using derogatory language or engaging in any improper conduct.
- Must be attentive to any special needs related to individual participants.
- Aid in written observation of daily activities and events.
- You are required to call in and notify staff if you are unable to make a scheduled volunteering session.
